



## **Commonly Asked Questions**

### **Who can be a street rep?**

Anyone can be a Street Rep. You just need a willingness to connect with your neighbours and help to share resources and information with them. It is great if you have a DBS, but it is not a requirement for this role.

### **What size an area will a Street Rep cover?**

It is suggested that Street Reps cover about 20 houses, this could be your road, close or flat block, or for just part of your road. You can choose how big an area you want to cover depending on the amount of time you can give. You may be able to find other street members who would like to help you and share the responsibilities.

### **Can I be a Street Rep if I already have a Neighbourhood Watch group or Residents Association?**

Having a Neighbourhood Watch Group or Residents Association on your road doesn't stop you being a Street Rep. We would like to work alongside and to help support these existing groups with additional information, resources and tools. We suggest talking to existing groups about the opportunity and benefits of you becoming a Street Rep.

### **What is the time commitment for a street rep?**

There isn't a specific time commitment, it is up to you how much time you would like to spend. If you are unable to carry on as a Street Rep please let us know and together we can try and find another street rep for your road.
